



Confidentiality Contract for Couple's Therapy

This contract is an agreement between the interested parties that neither party shall for any reason attempt to subpoena my testimony or my records to be presented in a deposition or court hearing of any kind for any reason, such as a divorce case.

Both parties acknowledge that the goal of psychotherapy, either individual or marital therapy, is for the sole purpose of the amelioration of psychological distress and that the process of psychotherapy depends on trust and openness during the therapy sessions.

Therefore, it is understood by both parties that if they request my services as a psychotherapist, they are expected NOT to use information given to me during the therapy process against the other party in a judicial setting of any kind, be it civil, criminal, or circuit.

Additionally, individual sessions, where I meet with each of you are often part of the couple's therapy process. You can expect at least one individual session at the beginning and occasionally additional sessions as necessary. It is important for you to know that **the purpose of these individual sessions is support the couple's process and therefore information shared in those sessions may be brought into the couple's process as I deem necessary.**
